The Florida Legislature authorized Citizens Property Insurance Corporation (Citizens) to develop a depopulation program to reduce the number of its policies and exposure. This program allows approved insurance companies to assume Citizens policies and provide offers of coverage.

A private insurance company has expressed an interest in providing insurance coverage for your property and has contacted your agent about assuming your policy. Your agent declined to participate in the assumption or did not respond to their request. Your Citizens policy cannot be assumed without your agent's consent.

Since a private insurance company may be able to offer you similar coverage, Citizens is required to notify you of the company's interest in your policy. If you would like to learn more about your coverage options in the private market which could reduce your assessment potential, you may:

- 1) Contact your agent. If he or she is appointed with a private carrier, they may be able to offer you a quote.
- 2) Request quotes through the Florida Market Assistance Program (FMAP). FMAP is designed to match consumers seeking property insurance with agents who can help. You can register for this free referral program at www.fmap.org.
