2020 Florida Market Assistance Plan Budget

The Florida Market Assistance Plan (FMAP) is a service organization created by the Legislature in 1985 under section 627.3515, F. S. This statute requires that FMAP assist applicants who are unable to acquire Property and Casualty insurance (excluding Workers Compensation, Employer's Liability, Malpractice, or Motor Vehicle insurance coverage) from authorized insurers.

The Board of Governors for FMAP is comprised of the same members as Citizens and is funded by the Corporation and a \$450 annual assessment of residential property insurers. The 2020 FMAP budget is presented below and includes 2019 projected revenues and expenses along with 2018 and 2017 audited financial results for comparison.
