Executive Summary

Board of Governors Meeting, September 23, 2020

Contract for Dental and Insurance Coverage

Topic

This Action Item requests Board approval of a new contract with Citizens incumbent provider of Dental Insurance Coverage programs, MetLife.

The new contract will take effect January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

History

MetLife is the incumbent provider and their current contract with Citizens for Dental Insurance Coverage concludes on December 31, 2020. A new contract with MetLife was competitively priced on behalf of Citizens by its Benefits Consultant, Mercer Health & Benefits, LLC.

The duration of the contract is for a one-year period due to the uncertainty of the external environment. Mercer's advice was that the current situation and external environment may affect Citizens prospects to obtain satisfactory long-term contractual terms. Mercer advised that pricing and other terms are likely to be more favorable after MetLife and other carriers better understand how the current situation will affect them.

For its part, MetLife offered more favorable terms for the new, one-year contract, which is effective January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021. The contract is estimated to be a 2% reduction from 2020 rates, a savings of approximately \$18,000.

Estimated total cost of Dental Insurance Coverage through MetLife for the contract period of January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021, is approximately \$846,208.

Citizens and its Employees both share in the contribution level cost at 85/15 percent:

- Citizens estimated cost \$729,297
- Employees estimated cost \$116,911

The actual total amount expended will be a function of employee enrollment in the MetLife Dental plan.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of Governors:

- a) Approve the one-year contract with MetLife at an estimated cost to Citizens of \$846,208 as described in this Action Item; and
- b) Authorize staff to take any appropriate or necessary action consistent with this Action Item.
