Dental Insurance Coverage

Topic

Citizens staff is requesting approval of a new contract with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Florida (Florida Blue) for Dental Insurance Coverage. The base term of the contract will be three (3) years with no renewal terms. The total contract amount for the three (3) year term is estimated at \$3,592,900 which is based upon per employee per month fees. The employee enrollment will fluctuate over the term of the contract and could impact the estimated total cost.

History

Mercer Health & Benefits, LLC (Mercer), Citizens' benefits consultant, completed a survey with several national carriers for dental insurance. This survey resulted in quotes ranging from rate decreases of -0.02% to increases up to 2.38% (based on the \$5,000 annual maximum level) for policies starting January 1, 2023. Mercer recommends that Citizens execute a three (3) year contract with Florida Blue for dental coverage through December 31, 2025.

Citizens is projected to have 1,364 full-time eligible employees as of January 1, 2023. MetLife is the current provider under a one (1) year contract for Dental Insurance Coverage which expires on December 31, 2022.

This recommendation to execute a new three (3) year contract with Florida Blue will result in a guaranteed rate (which did not increase from last year's contract amount with MetLife) for the first two years of the contract. A rate increase, based on claims experience, not to exceed 5%, was negotiated for the third year of the contract term. In addition to a strong provider network to meet Citizens employees' dental provider needs, Florida Blue will provide a one-month ASO fee waiver for the medical and prescription plan.

The spend authority requested from the board for the contract term of January 1, 2023, through December 31, 2025, is approximately \$3,592,900. This cost assumes 1,364 participating employees. The numbers used to project contract spend are based upon the presumption of 1,364 employees with full participation. However, the participation rate will not be determined until after the open enrollment period for each calendar year of coverage. As well, employee participation counts will change during each contract year. This method of projection will allow for flexibility for the term of the contract.
