#### **Outgoing Shipping Services**

#### **Topic**

This Action Item requests approval to 1) increase the current contract/purchase order spend authority with FedEx for an additional \$62,000 for the remainder of the current contract term; and 2) enter into a contract/purchase order with FedEx Corporate Services, Inc. ("FedEx") for outgoing shipping services with an expected spend of \$472,000 through November 27, 2026. The current contract expires September 21, 2024.

#### **History**

Citizens utilizes shipping services to ensure outgoing mail such as overnight policyholder checks, agent commission checks, ad-hoc vendor payments, equipment/supply shipments, and business unit correspondence is delivered using a timely, reliable, and trackable method. The continuation of these services is vital to ongoing operations.

Citizens is requesting an increase in authorized spend for the existing contract of \$62,000. The request to increase authorized spend is due to increased usage aligned with Citizens' policy growth, hurricane response activities, unanticipated freight charges, and rising shipping rates due to inflation. The increase will result in a total authorized spend for the current contract of \$432,000.

Projected future costs of outgoing shipping services under the new contract are based on the prior 16 months of incurred expenses, an average of over 1,600 shipments per month, under the current contract. The terms and pricing under the new contract will remain consistent with the current contract. The contract will be effective September 22, 2024 and will expire November 27, 2026, for a term slightly over two years and for an amount of \$472,000.

Citizens leverages the Alternative Contract Source ("ACS") FedEx Corporate Services, Inc. 78102200-21-NASPO-ACS established by the Florida Department of Management Services to purchase outgoing shipping services with FedEx the only provider of services under this contract. Citizens is permitted to make purchases from the ACS as an "eligible user" in accordance with s. 627.351(6)(e)1, Florida Statutes and 287.057, Florida Statutes.

An ACS is a contract by a federal, state, or local government that has been approved by the Secretary of the Department of Management Services, based on a determination that the contract is cost-effective and the best value to the state for use by Florida agencies for purchases, without the requirement of competitive procurement. Alternate contract sources are authorized by subsection 287.042(16), Florida Statutes.
