Enterprise Litigation Management System – Mitratech Additional Spend

Topic

This Action Item seeks Board approval for an additional \$350,000 in authorized spend under the Enterprise Litigation Management System "ELMS" contract with Trialnet, Inc. D/B/A Acuity Management Solutions, a Subsidiary of Mitratech Holdings, Inc. "Mitratech".

History

The Enterprise Litigation Management System is used by both Citizens' internal staff and contracted outside defense counsel to facilitate the management of all activity on claims related legal matters, including data analysis and reporting, management and auditing and payment of all law firm and litigation vendor billing, storage of all litigation related documents and communication between Citizens and its contracted outside defense counsel. Citizens is currently in a transition period with Mitratech supporting the existing ELMS system, named "Acuity", while staff works with Litify, Inc. to implement the new ELMS solution procured under ITN 22-0019.

On April 10, 2024, the Board approved additional spend in the amount of \$1,000,000 to provide for the anticipated "go-live" date of October 2024. Using best efforts from all involved, and to avoid a bifurcated implementation and ensure the delivery of full system functionality, the "go-live" date was moved by mutual consent to May of 2025. Until the "go-live" date, the Acuity system will be needed to continue providing critical ELMS services for Citizens. This additional approval will increase the total spend authorized for Mitratech's ELMS services to \$3,300,000.

The current contract for ELMS, with Mitratech Holdings, Inc. ("Mitratech"), dates to April 30, 2012, following the completion of ITN 11-0054. This resulted in the contract with Acuity Management Solutions ("Acuity"). On September 29, 2020, Acuity was acquired by Mitratech, who continued the Software-as-a-Service ("SaaS") solution, now called "Acuity ELM Essentials."

Mitratech is currently providing these ELMS services through the Acuity platform, after choosing not to participate in ITN 22-0019. That procurement resulted in the contract award to Litify, Inc. (Litify) for a new ELMS system which is currently being implemented. Thereafter, Single Source 22-2003 procured Mitratech to contractually continue the required services, both in maintaining the current operating system and assisting with the successful transition to the new vendor, Litify, Inc. This contract with Mitratech will expire on June 18, 2025, without any available renewal options. Citizens anticipates the remaining time prior to Mitratech's Acuity contract expiration will allow for the successful implementation and transition to Litify.

The original estimated contract amount for the Acuity ELMS services was \$1,950,000 for a recommended three (3) year contract period. This estimate for funding was based on certain assumptions pertaining to litigation volume and associated litigation expenses known at the time. On March 28, 2024, the Board approved an additional \$1,000,000 in Board authority due to increased

litigation volume and increased hourly rates for contracted outside counsel, as well as ongoing transition assistance by Acuity personnel. At that time, spend estimates for the Acuity system were based on an October 2024 "go-live" date for the Litify system and did not contemplate the need for Citizens to continue the Acuity ELMS platform through May 2025. As such, this request for additional spend under the Mitratech agreement is needed to allow continuity of ELMS services while Citizens continues its partnership with Litify to complete the implementation of the new system.

Given (1) the criticality of the ELMS system to Citizens' Claims Litigation operations and the need for continued services, (2) Mitratech being the current provider of those services through the Acuity platform, and (3) the time and process required to ensure a successful transition to the new Litify ELMS system, the attached Consent Item seeks Board approval for an additional \$350,000 in spend under the Mitratech ELMS agreement.

Recommendation

The recommendation is listed in the attached Action Item.

This additional request seeks \$350,000 for funding of existing ELMS services through the June 18, 2025, Mitratech contract expiration.
