CONTRACT ID:	Water Mitigation Estimate Review Program VENDOR: LYNX SERVICES, LLC REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL SPENDING AUTHORITY
BUDGETED ITEM	Yes. However, current estimates indicate initial approved contract spend will be depleted by approximately June 2019.
CONTRACT AMOUNT	The Board of Governors approved a total initial contract spend of \$1,829,065 in July 2016. This Consent Item is requesting an additional \$1,590,935 in funds be approved to cover expenses for the life of the contract; of this amount, \$144,000 represents the cost of Resolution Support Services as a billable item.
CONTRACT TERM(S)	The current contract has a three (3) year base term, with two (2) optional, one-year renewal terms.
PURPOSE/SCOPE	This Consent Item seeks Board approval on the following: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) To increase the total contract spending authority from \$1,829,065 to \$3,420,000. This increase in authorized spend is necessary to cover expenses associated with the increased volume of non-weather water related losses as well as the rise in non-weather water related claims that go into litigation; and2) To amend the terms of the current contract to include Resolution Support Services as a billable item. Resolution Support Services involve explaining and justifying vendor's assessment and as part of litigation support. Of the total \$1,590,935 of additional contract spend being requested, approximately \$144,000 is associated with this Resolution Support Services.
PROCUREMENT METHOD	On March 16, 2016, Citizens issued Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 16-0007 for Water Mitigation Estimate Review. Responses were received and scored by an Evaluation Committee. The Evaluation Committee recommended primary award to one (1) vendor on June 9, 2016, with one (1) contingent vendor.
RECOMMENDATION	Staff recommends the Citizens' Board: <ol style="list-style-type: none">a) Approve the recommended increase of the total contract spend authority by \$1,590,935 to a total of \$3,420,000 for Water Mitigation Estimate Review Program, RFP 16-0007 for the life of the contract;b) Approve the contract amendment to provide Resolution Support Services as a billable item;c) Authorize staff to take any appropriate or necessary actions consistent with this Consent Item.
